O R D E R

By an order dated 2.3.2020, this Court extended the time given to the applicant(s)/auction purchasers to deposit the balance amount till 20.3.2020. Later, time for deposit of the amount was extended till 30.4.2020 vide order dated 20.3.2020. The applicant seeks further extension of time as he has not been able to raise the amount due to the ongoing pandemic.

Mr. O.P. Gaggar, learned counsel appearing for the Bank opposes the extension by submitting that the initial order of deposit was passed on 6.2.2020 and the applicant ought to have deposited the amount pursuant to the said order.

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties, we are of the opinion that the time granted for deposit of the balance amount should be extended in view of the disability caused due to

lockdown. We, therefore, extend the time to deposit the remaining amount for two months after lifting of the lockdown. The applicant is directed to pay interest at the lending rate for the period starting from 20.03.2020 till the date of deposit.

M.A. stands disposed of accordingly.
