O R D E R

The petitioner seeks bail on various grounds. One of the grounds is that his sister's wedding is fixed on 15.06.2020.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State, we are of the opinion that the petitioner does not deserve any sympathy at the hands of this Court insofar as other grounds are concerned as urged by the petitioner. However, taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has to attend his sister's wedding on 15.06.2020, we deem it proper to release the petitioner on bail for a temporary period of three

weeks on the following conditions apart from other conditions to be imposed by the Trial Court:

1. The petitioner has to mark his attendance to the Station House Officer (SHO) of the local Police Station everyday between 09.00 a.m to 12.00 noon;
2. This order of bail subsists till the end of June, 2020;
3. The petitioner shall surrender voluntarily before the end of June, 2020 before the jurisdictional local police station for being sent to judicial custody.

It is open for the petitioner to seek order of bail afresh subsequently.

The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
