O R D E R

The present Special Leave Petitions are directed against the self-same judgment of the Division Bench of the High Court dated 23.12.2016, while concurring with the view expressed by the learned Single Judge under its order dated 21.09.2016, that the petitioners are entitled for their monetary benefits in terms of notification dated 29.05.2002 modified the relief restricted to three years prior to the date of petition and shall not get any interest on arrears.

It is informed to this Court by the respondent's counsel Mr.S.Chakravorty, that in terms of the judgment impugned of the Division Bench of the High Court dated 23.12.2016 arrears have been made over to the petitioners.

After we have heard the learned counsel for the parties, we are not inclined to interfere in the impugned judgment and at the same time consider it appropriate to observe that if the payment is still due and payable to the petitioners in terms of the judgment of the Division Bench of the High Court dated 23.12.2016 the same shall be made over to each of them within a period of three months from today.

In the above terms, the Special Leave Petitions are disposed of.
