Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner.

We see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court.

The petitioner shall vacate and handover peaceful possession of the suit premises to the respondent/plaintiff on or prior to 30.11.2021. The petitioner shall also file an undertaking to this effect in this Court within a period of two weeks from today. On failure to file such an undertaking, the protection granted shall stand automatically revoked.
