O R D E R

This Special Leave Petition arising out of High Court judgment for quashing of FIR is rejected.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to take recourse to other appropriate remedies as may be permissible in law, including

to apply for regular bail.

No coercive action be taken against the petitioners for a period of two weeks to enable them to surrender before the concerned Court and apply for regular bail. If petitioners give advance notice of 48 hours to the public prosecutor before moving the bail application, the trial Court may consider the bail application preferably on the same day. Needless to observe that the bail application be decided on its own merits without being influenced by any observation in the impugned judgment. All contentions and remedies available to the petitioners are left open.

The Special Leave Petition is dismissed accordingly.
