O R D E R

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties at length.

A perusal of the interim order shows that the High Court has cancelled the bail application of the petitioners which is the subject matter of these Special Leave Petitions.

It was brought to our notice by the learned counsel appearing for the respondents that investigation is completed and charge-sheet is filed in the matter.

Under the circumstances, we direct the petitioners to surrender before the concerned Trial Court and file application seeking regular bail in the matter. The bail application shall be considered by the Trial Court on its own merits and in accordance with law.

Any observation made by the High Court, while considering the application for cancellation of bail, shall not affect the rights of the parties in the Trial Court.

The Special Leave Petitions are disposed of in the afore-stated terms.

Pending applications filed in the matters also stand disposed of.
