O R D E R

The interim order of status *quo* was granted on 13.02.2020, as, according to the petitioner, Rule 11(j) of the Tamil Nadu G.O. No. 256 of 2015 dated 22.12.2015 has been violated in the present case as the distance between the Petroleum Retail Outlet sought to be set up and the school is within the prohibited distance of 100 meters. (The petitioner's writ petition states that it is within 50 meters from the school).

On 19.03.2020, when the matter came up again before the High

Court, only Respondent Nos. 1-5 were heard and the interim order of status *quo*, that was granted on 13.02.2020, was vacated summarily without giving any reason. Thereafter, the matter was directed to be listed on 23.03.2020.

We are informed that the matter has not come up since. We request the High Court to take up the matter and dispose of the same within a period of two weeks from today.

The Special Leave Petitions are disposed of accordingly.

Pending application also stands disposed of.
