UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

We decline to interfere with the impugned judgment and order refusing to grant anticipatory bail. The special leave petition is dismissed accordingly.

However, dismissal of this special leave petition will not come in the way of the petitioner to pursue regular bail application in connection with F.I.R. No. 694 dated 30.11.2020 registered at P.S. Civil Lines, Chhattarpur, Madhya Pradesh, which he may file within two weeks from today after surrendering before the concerned Court.

Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner but the petitioner shall make himself available

before the Investigating Officer as and when required in connection with the investigation of the subject case.

If 48 hours advance notice is given to the local public prosecutor before moving the bail application, the concerned Court may decide the bail application preferably on the same day on its own merits and in accordance with law uninfluenced by any observation in the impugned judgment and order.

Pending applications stand disposed of.
