UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The instant special leave petitions arise out of order dated 8th January, 2019 passed by the High Court of Kerala in FAO No. 146 of 2016.
2. By the effect of the impugned order, the High Court reversed the order of temporary injunction dated 5th February, 2016 passed by the trial Court in favour of the plaintiff-appellants.
3. While entertaining these special leave petitions, an interim order dated 15th April, 2019 was passed directing the parties to maintain status quo.
4. During the course of submissions, the learned counsel for the parties apprised the Court that the original suit is still pending.
5. In this view of the matter, we hereby direct the learned trial Judge to decide the Original Suit No. 95/2015 preferably within a period of one year from today.
6. Needless to say that interim order dated 15th April, 2019 passed by this Court would continue to operate till the disposal of the suit.
7. The special leave petitions stand disposed of

accordingly.
