UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

While dismissing the special leave petition, this Court by its order dated 11.12.2019 had granted to the petitioner time of six months to vacate subject to the filing of usual undertaking within four weeks from the date of the order.

In this application, it is now submitted that because of the lockdown pursuant to the Pandemic of COVID-19, it would not be possible for the petitioner to vacate the premises. It is further submitted that the petitioner and his family are residing in the city of Kanpur which has been declared as Red Zone. The

application, therefore, prays for extension of time to vacate the premises by six more months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however restricted his prayer and submitted that extension of time by three months would be sufficient.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we accept the request and grant further time of three months to vacate the premises, subject to the filing of usual undertaking within two weeks from today.

In case, the undertaking is not filed within the period of two weeks, the benefit of this order shall not enure to the advantage of the petitioner.

The miscellaneous application stands disposed of accordingly.
