O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard the learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners and carefully perusing the material on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court rejecting the anticipatory bail application of the petitioners

The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, taking into consideration the facts and circumstance of this case, four weeks' time from today is granted to the petitioners to surrender before the concerned Court and apply for

regular bail. Upon surrender, if the petitioners apply for regular bail, the said Court is directed to deal and decide the said application expeditiously on its own merits and in accordance with law. No coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioners for a period of four weeks from today.

Pending application filed in the matter also stands disposed of.
