ORDER

The explanation given by the petitioner in application for condonation is far from satisfactory. We however condone the delay of 171 days in filing the review petition.

The chronology of events indicates that at every stage the petitioner was guilty of latches in raising challenge against the orders against him. The basic order of imposition of penalty of censure was passed against the petitioner in January 1995 and the rest of the proceedings are consequential in nature. We have gone through the review petition and do not see any error apparent on record to justify interference in review jurisdiction. This review petitions are therefore dismissed.
