O R D E R

We have heard Mr. Manohar Pratap, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and also Mr. Sourabh Ajay Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Chhattisgarh.

The petitioner-Abhay Singh is involved in four cases as under:

By perusal of the jail custody certificate we have seen that the petitioner is in jail from 20.11.2016.

Mr. Sourabh Ajay Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State, has submitted that the charge-sheet in all the aforesaid cases has been filed. Mr. Manohar Pratap, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, has submitted that all the accused were also granted bail.

In view of the submissions made at the Bar and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case that the charge-sheet has been filed in all the aforesaid cases and also considering the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, the petitioner-Abhay Singh is ordered to be released on bail in all the four cases subject to his executing bail bonds for a sum of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court. The two sureties shall hold good for all the four cases.

The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence in any manner and shall render cooperation with the progress of the trial.

The special leave petitions are accordingly disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
