O R D E R

We have perused the counter affidavit filed by the State. Since the appointment on *ad hoc* basis was irregular, the impugned order was interfered with vide order dated 3.7.2018. We have, however, directed that the petitioner who has worked as a Teacher in the School would be paid the salary and other permissible allowances.

In view of the facts and circumstances, it is clear that such liability would be of the School Management alone who has not been impleaded as a respondent. The liability cannot be of the State of Uttar Pradesh and the sole liability would have to be borne by the School Management.

If the School Management does not re-compensate the petitioner for this period of time, it is open for the petitioner to move contempt proceedings against the Management alone.

The Contempt Petition is dismissed with the aforesaid observations.
