Having heard Ms.Manjeet Chawla, learned counsel for the appellant, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court whereby the High Court has enhanced certain amount of compensation keeping in view the condition of the victims. Though learned counsel for the appellant has raised an issue with regard to percentage relating to future prospect, we do not intend to interfere regard being had to the quantum involved in exercise of jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution.

The appeals are accordingly dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.

However, if the appellant has not deposited the enhanced amount, it may do so within twelve weeks hence. As far as interest
