ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Respondent no. 1 has filed an application for modification of this Court's judgment dated 26.09.2019 in the aforementioned appeal. In para 6 of the judgment it is written, "Respondent No. 1 Meghalaya Wakf Board, is agreeable to appoint the appellant as a joint mutawalli along with Respondent no.2."

Learned counsel for the applicant prays that instead of the words "the appellant", "any competent person from amongst Kammu Mia's lineal descendants including female" may be mentioned. Mr. Mukesh Giri, learned counsel appearing for the appellant has no objection to the above said prayer.

Therefore, in para 6 of the judgment dated 26.09.2019, the above-mentioned portion shall be read as under:

"Respondent No. 1 Meghalaya Wakf Board, is agreeable to appoint any competent person from amongst Kammu Mia's lineal descendants, including descendants through the female line, as a joint mutawalli along with Respondent no.2."
