O R D E R

Permission to file Special Leave Petition is granted.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and having perused the material placed on record, we are not persuaded to consider interference of the order dated 17.05.2021, whereby the High Court had only adjourned the matter for consideration at later date.

However, on being queried with the other issues regarding letter/communication dated 17.05.2021 issued by the Ministry of Defence, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submitted that the order was received late in the evening and only after the matter was adjourned in the High Court.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances, though we find no reason to consider interference in this petition, but leave it open for the petitioner in taking recourse to appropriate remedies in accordance with law, including making of a fresh prayer for appropriate interim relief before the High Court in the pending petition.

We hope and trust that if any such prayer is made on behalf of the petitioner, the same shall be given due consideration by the High Court.

The Special Leave Petition and pending application(s) are disposed of accordingly.
