Applications for exemption from filing notarized affidavit, affidavit and permission to file additional documents are allowed.

I.A. NO. 98665/2021- INTERVENTION

The applicant was a party before the Single Judge but chose to accept the judgment and not challenge it before the Division Bench. The applicant now seeks to get itself impleaded in the present proceedings on the basis of a reference made by the State Government in its counter affidavit.

We find the aforesaid process irregular and thus, are not inclined to entertain the application.

The application is dismissed.
