Heard Mr. Aneesh Mittal, learned counsel for the petitioner-wife and also Mr. Amol Chitale, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-husband. Both parties are also participating in the proceeding through the virtual mode.

Parties have reached a mutual agreement and the terms are reduced into writing on 21.03.2022 and both have appended their signature.

In terms of the said settlement, a sum of Rs.22 Lakhs (Twenty two lakhs) by way of demand draft has been furnished to the petitioner by the respondent. The petitioner has acknowledged receipt of the demand draft and she has deposited the same into her bank account.

The details of the cases pending between the parties are incorporated in paragraph 7 of the settlement and they have agreed to withdraw their respective cases. They will abide by the terms of settlement.

In view of above, we deem it appropriate to invoke our power under Article 142 of the Constitution and order for dissolution of marriage between *Harsha and Aarthik Kanal*. A decree be drawn up accordingly.

The transfer petition is disposed of in above terms.
