O R D E R

We have heard Dr. KSV Pillai, the petitioner in person. He submits that Soap Aroma Aerosol Action Preventive Therapy - Mask (SAAPT Mask) is very useful and shall save the world from this pandemic.

We are of the view that it is for the Authorities concerned including ICMR to consider any proposal or any scientific invention. This Court under Article 32 of the Constitution can neither entertain such claim nor can investigate the genuineness of such claim. If so advised, the petitioner may approach the

competent authorities. In so far as other prayers are concerned, no such direction can be passed in this writ petition filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India.

With these observations, the writ petition is dismissed.
