O R D E R

This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of Case being H.M.A.No.212 of 2017 titled *Arvind Kumar v. Pooja* pending before Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohini, Delhi to a competent Family Court in Bihar.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the hardships which will be faced by the petitioner in contesting the case at Delhi, we deem it proper to allow the transfer petition and direct transfer of the abovementioned case from Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohini, Delhi to District Judge, Chhapra, Bihar. It is accordingly ordered. The District Judge, Chhapra, Bihar shall assign the case to a Family Court having competent jurisdiction.
