O R D E R

The writ petition has been filed by the petitioner who claims to be a qualified BA MS doctor and has some cure for Covid-19 in the form of a desi version of the medicine and a direction is sought in the petition under Article 32 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the Secretary, Health Department, Government of India to use the medicines made by the petitioner for treating Covid-19.

We are of the view that such kind of petitions must be stopped as anybody and everybody thinks they have some cure for the situation and seek to invoke the jurisdiction of this Court under

Article 32 of the Constitution possibly only to gain some publicity. Such wastage of judicial time is completely inappropriate.

We dismiss the writ petition with cost of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the Supreme Court Advocates-on-Record Welfare Fund within four weeks.
