O R D E R

This Court had while issuing notice directed the petitioner to deposit ₹ 13 lakhs i.e. principal sum. Having heard learned counsel, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner should

deposit a further sum of ₹ 6 lakhs within eight weeks before the trial court.

Subject to compliance with this direction, the impugned order, is modified. In stead of double the amount (₹ 26 lakhs) the direction shall be substituted with the sum of ₹ 19 lakhs.

In case the petitioner fails to comply with the direction and deposit the amount within the time specified, the impugned order shall revive.

The special leave petition is disposed of.
