Leave granted.

The appellant seeks enhancement of compensation as granted by the High Court for Rs.5,35,000/- per acre in view of the land acquisition proceedings. The notification under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 was issued by acquiring authority on on 20.6.2002.

This Court in Civil Appeal Nos.2881-2910 of 2010 with regard to the same notification concerning lands in the same village as that of the appellants, the acquisition being for the same purpose, has granted compensation at the rate of Rs. 10,00,000/- per acre.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

No one appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 despite valid service of notice.

The appellant is therefore entitled to the same rate of compensation at the rate of Rs.10,00,000/- per acre on principles of parity there being no difference.

Needless to state that the appellant shall not be entitled for interest for the period of delay.

In view of the above, Civil Appeal is allowed.
