O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

The petitioner-wife seeks transfer of Case No. HMG Act/10/2020 under Section 6 of Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act titled as "*Ajay Singh Sindhu v. Sangeeta*" pending before the Additional District and Sessions Judge, Principal Judge, Family Court, Sonipat, Haryana to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Family Court, Sangaria, Hanumangarh, Rajasthan.

It is not in dispute that the Divorce Case filed by the respondent-husband has already been transferred by this Court from Sonipat to the Family Court Hanumangarh (Rajasthan). It would be, thus, in the interest of justice and equity that both the cases are heard together.

The Transfer Petition is accordingly allowed. The case No. HMG Act/10/2020 titled as "*Ajay Singh Sindhu v.*

Sangeeta" pending before the Additional District and Sessions Judge, Principal Judge, Family Court, Sonipat, Haryana is ordered to be transferred to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Family Court, Sangaria, Hanumangarh, Rajasthan.

The Original Records shall be transferred to the transferee court forthwith.

The Family Court shall make an endeavour to fix both divorce case and custody case on the same date to cause minimum hardship to the parties. The court shall make further endeavour for amicable settlement of the dispute through mediation, if possible.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
