O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 25 of the Civil Procedure Code has been filed by the petitioner (wife) for transfer of divorce proceedings in M.C. No.94 of 2019 titled as "Sri Ashish vs. Smt. Harsha" pending in the Court of Senior Civil Judge, Kolar Gold Fields in the State of Karnataka to the Family Court, Chennai in the State of Tamil Nadu.

After hearing learned counsel for parties and keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the Divorce Petition bearing MC No. 94/2019 titled as "Sri Ashish vs. Smt. Harsha" pending in the Court of Senior Civil Judge, Kolar Gold Fields, Karnataka is ordered to be transferred to the Family Court, Chennai (Tamil Nadu). The Court at Kolar Gold Field shall transfer the records immediately to the Family Court, Chennai. Since there is a possibility of amicable resolution of the matrimonial dispute, learned counsel for parties have agreed to approach the Mediation Centre of High Court of Madras to mediate between the parties. The

Family Court at Chennai shall keep the proceedings pending during the pendency of mediation proceedings.

The Transfer Petition is allowed in the afore-stated terms.

Pending application filed in the matter also stands disposed of.
