Considering the fact that at the time of death of the deceased employee, no regularisation order was passed and he continued as work-charged employee and even as mentioned in Office Memorandum dated 04.07.2015, after the order of 2005 his case for regularisation on the post of Peon was considered and his services were not regularised as Peon as the deceased employee was not having requisite qualification and even his

services were not regularised on the post of *Beldar* as there were other persons senior to him and as a work-charged employee his heirs are not entitled to the appointment on compassionate ground, the Division Bench of the High Court has rightly not interfered with the order passed by learned Single Judge. The Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.
