We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner-husband is convicted under Section 304-B IPC and sentenced to undergo imprisonment for seven years.

So far as the co-accused Murti Devi and Jai Parkash are concerned, vide order dated 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 we have issued notice mainly on the ground that they were not residing along with the deceased in the matrimonial house. The petitioner-husband is not similarly situated as that of the co-accused qua whom the notice was issued by this Court.

We have perused the impugned judgment and materials on record regarding the petitioner-husband. We do not find any good ground warranting interference with the impugned judgment in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.

The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.
