O R D E R

This petition has been filed against an order passed by the High Court refusing to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner who was involved in an offence punishable under Section 406 of the IPC. Dispute relates to payment of Rs.31 lakhs by the petitioner to

the complainant.

Notice was issued by this Court on 25.06.2020 after recording the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner shall deposit Rs.31 lakhs if reasonable time is given. Initially, an amount of Rs.10 lakhs was directed to be deposited within 15 days from the date of the order i.e. 25.06.2020. Eight weeks' time was granted to deposit the remaining amount of Rs.21 lakhs. The period within which the deposit had to be made was extended by this Court on 03.09.2021. It was made clear in the said order that no further extension shall be granted beyond 30.09.2021.

We are informed by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the orders passed by this Court on 25.06.2020 and 03.09.2021 have not been complied with.

The special leave petition is dismissed. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.

The application for bail shall be decided on its own merits. The amount of Rs.10 lakhs deposited by the petitioner shall be paid to the respondent No.2.
