O R D E R

In pursuance of the order dated 9 May 2019, the petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs 25 lakhs before the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission¹.

During the course of the hearing, it has been agreed that:

(i) The petitioner shall deposit a further sum of Rs 10 lakhs before the SCDRC within a period of six weeks from today;

(ii) The respondents would be at liberty to withdraw the amount of Rs 25 lakhs which has been deposited so far and the additional amount of Rs 10 lakhs to be deposited in terms of the above directions;

(iii) Since the dispute has been resolved between the parties in the above terms, no further directions have been sought on either side;

(iv) All the proceedings that have been instituted by the respondents in regard to the transactions which form the subject matter of the Special Leave Petitions shall stand concluded with the passing of the present order which is in full and final settlement of all the claims;

(v) The above settlement has been arrived at in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and since there has been a mutually agreed settlement, no opinion has been expressed by the Court on the merits of the rival contentions which were raised in the present proceedings.

The Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of in the above terms.

Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
