UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

This petition under Article 32 of the Constitution of India seeks following reliefs:-

"a) Issue a writ of Mandamus or any appropriate writ, order or direction to State of U.P. to release pending honour money, free transport and free medical facility to petitioner/freedom fighters for democracy;

b) Direct the Central Bureau of Investigation or any other central independent agencies to conduct an impartial and fair inquiry of criminal cases registered against the petitioner at various police station at Mathura District, U.P. when he was in jail or other place.

c) Issue a writ of Mandamus or any appropriate writ, order or direction to quash Criminal Case No. 15/15, dated 22.01.2015 P.S.Mitauli, Sadar Bazar, Mathura, U.P. u/s 147, 148, 149,353, 332, 323, 324, 307, 395 of IPC and 7 Criminal

Law Amendment Act pending before Mathura District, U.P.

d) Issue a writ of Mandamus or any appropriate writ, order or direction to quash FIR No. 203/15 PS Sadar Bazar U/s 38 of Electricity Act at District Mathura, U.P. dated 15.06.2015 pending before Mathura District, U.P.

e) Issue a writ of Mandamus or any appropriate writ, order or direction to quash Criminal Case No.171/16 dated 4.4.2016 P.S. Sadar Bazar, Mathura U.P. u/s 147, 148, 149, 323, 392 of IPC and 7 Criminal Law Amendment Act pending before Mathura District U.P.

f) Issue a writ of Mandamus or any appropriate writ, order or direction to quash Criminal Case No.174/16 dated 8.4.2016 P.S. Sadar Bazar, Mathura U.P. u/s 147, 148, 149, 323, 332, 352, 353 of IPC and 7 Criminal Law Amendment Act pending before Mathura District U.P.

g) Issue a writ of Mandamus or any appropriate writ, order or direction to quash Criminal Case No.419/16 dated 25.5.2016 P.S. Raya, Mathura U.P. u/s 147, 148, 332, 447, 353, 427 of IPC and 3 Sampati Niwara Adhiniyam, 1984 pending before Mathura District U.P."

The additional affidavit filed by the petitioner indicates that the cases referred to in prayers (c) to (g) have been going on before the concerned courts for some length of time.

In the circumstances, we see no reason to entertain this writ petition.

We, therefore, dismiss the writ petition but leave all the remedies and recourses open to the petitioner to be taken up at the appropriate stages in the concerned criminal cases.

As regards, prayer (a), the petitioner is at liberty to take appropriate steps in the matter.

The writ petition is disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
