O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Application seeking exemption from filing original attested affidavit and welfare stamps is allowed.

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and perusing the material available on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court dismissing the bail application of the petitioner.

We find that the High Court in its impugned order dated 17-3-2020 while dismissing the bail application of the petitioner, directed the concerned Trial Court to complete the trial within a period of one year.

In case the Trial is not concluded, as scheduled by the High Court, the petitioner would be at liberty to move the trial court for regular bail which shall be decided on its own merits and in accordance with law.

With the above observation, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

Pending applications filed in the matter also stand disposed of.
