A Memorandum has been filed by the respondent-contemnor stating therein that as he is suffering from serious ailment, he is not in a position to be personally present in the Court and further that he has handed over possession of the premises on 31.08.2017. Considering the facts in entirety, while we drop the contempt proceedings, we direct the respondent-contemnor to pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) to the petitioner-Trust for occupation charges for eight months. The same shall be paid within eight weeks hence.

With the aforesaid observations, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
