UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Application seeking exemption from filing attested affidavit and affixing welfare stamp on Vakalatnama is allowed.

Having heard the learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, learned Deputy Advocate General appearing for the State of Madhya Pradesh and taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has already undergone 1 year and 5 months in jail, we are inclined to grant him bail.

The petitioner is, therefore, directed to be released on bail subject to the condition that he shall stay in Indore, Madhya Pradesh till the trial concludes in the matter.

We grant liberty to the concerned Trial Court to impose such other terms and conditions which it shall deem fit to impose upon the petitioner.

We make it clear that if any violation is noticed on the part of the petitioner with regard to influencing the witnesses or interfering with the process of the trial, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move the application before us for cancellation of bail which is being granted today.

The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, disposed of in the afore-stated terms.

Pending applications filed in the matter also stand disposed of.
