O R D E R

Mr. Jayant Bhushan, learned senior counsel for the petitioner, has drawn our attention to the Order dated 2.11.2018 passed by this Court in S.L.P. (Cr1.) No. 9017 of 2018 etc. titled "Sachidanand

Dubey vs. Union of India & Anr., which was a case of the co-accused, and the following Order was passed:

"Heard learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner.

In the nature of order we propose to pass, notice need not be issued to the respondents.

The petitioner is aggrieved since his application(s) under Section 482 have been dismissed by the High Court.

On a query, it is pointed out that the investigation has been completed and the police has filed its report(s) under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. before the Trial Court and the Court has summoned the petitioner.

The petitioner may surrender before the Trial Court within four weeks from today and on such surrender the petitioner shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond to the tune of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two solvent sureties for the like amount and subject to any other conditions that may be fixed by the Trial Court.

It will also be open to the petitioner(s) to file application for discharge, in which case the same will be considered on its own merits.

The special leave petitions are, accordingly, disposed of."

We dispose of these Special Leave Petitions on the same terms. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
