O R D E R

This is a petition filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the H.M.O.P. No. 3497 of 2018 titled as Ankur Khandelwal vs. Aakansha pending before the Family Court Chennai Tamil Nadu to the Family Court at Raipur, Chhattisgarh.

Heard Ms. Lakshmi, learned counsel for the petitioner. Though served, none appeared on behalf of the respondent.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to allow this transfer petition. Accordingly, the H.M.O.P. No. 3497 of 2018 titled as Ankur Khandelwal vs. Aakansha pending before the Family Court Chennai Tamil Nadu is transferred to the Family Court at Raipur, Chhattisgarh.
