We see no reason to interfere considering that the dilapidated building is 78 years old. However, Shri Navare, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners, has pointed out paragraphs 18, 19 and 20 of the reply that was filed by respondent No. 5 in Writ Petition (C)No. 7146 of 2015. The aforesaid reply makes it clear that an undertaking and declaration has been given by the landlord which has not been adverted to by the impugned judgment. We permit Shri Navare to move the High court for a clarification of the impugned judgment and order to this effect.

The special leave petition stands disposed of.
