O R D E R

IA No. 249969/2023 - IMPLEADMENT, IA No. 249963/2023 - IMPLEADMENT
& IA No. 249956/2023 - IMPLEADMENT

1. The learned counsel for the applicants are desirous and willing to participate in the Transfer Petition as Respondents and inadvertently in the prayer clause, it is stated that let the applicants be impleaded as party petitioners in the petition.
2. The learned counsel orally prayed for amendment in the prayer clause of the applications. The oral prayer is allowed. The modification in the prayer clause be carried out forthwith.
3. The learned counsel invites my attention to paragraph Nos.1 and 2 in support of the prayer.
4. The counsel representing the petitioner namely "Indian Bank Association" submits that the petitioner is having no objection for impleadment of the applicants as respondents to the petition.
5. Applications for impleadment are allowed.

IA No. 146326/2023 - INTERVENTION/IMPLEADMENT:-

1. The application for impleadment is filed at the instance of the petitioner.
2. The learned counsel submits that when the Transfer Petition was listed before the Court on 4-7-2023, notice was issued and at the same time, this Court permitted the petitioners to implead all the writ petitioners in the High Court so that they are put to notice about the present Transfer Petition. The petitioners have filed this impleadment application and list of those petitioners is referred to in a tabular form in paragraph 5 of the IA.
3. Accordingly, the application is allowed and the petitioners are permitted to implead the writ petitioners as party Respondent Nos.37 to 165.
4. Learned counsel submits that he is representing Respondent Nos.1, 6, 9, 14 and 16 and has filed Vakalatnama for Respondent No.1 also on record. Learned counsel submits that due to inadvertence, the Office Report fails to take note of this fact.

5. Accordingly, the counsel be shown for Respondent No.1 also henceforth.

6. Learned counsel prays for and is granted four weeks' time to file counter affidavit to the petition.
