

The petitioner is, accordingly, directed to be enlarged on bail on such terms and conditions which the concerted Trial Court shall deem fit and appropriate to impose upon him. However, we clarify that the order has been passed in the given facts of the case and not to be treated as precedent.

If the petitioner violates any condition of bail, the State of Rajasthan would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail which is being granted today by us.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the afore-stated terms.
