UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Memorandum of Settlement dated 10th January, 2020 has been filed and verified by the learned counsels as having been entered into inter-se the parties to resolve the dispute. The consent terms as set out in the Memorandum of Settlement which is signed between the petitioner-Management and the respondents before the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Aurangabad. The settlement is also signed by 21 workmen with the exception of No.22 Shrikrishna. We are informed that the said workman is not traceable even as per the respondents.

2. We have perused the settlement which has been arrived at through the process of mediation in terms whereof the workmen will be given a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs) per workman in full and final settlement of all their claims. The amounts are stated to have been paid to the workmen except to one person referred aforesaid whose compensation may be deposited with the Labour Commissioner to be released to him, when he is located.

3. We thus direct the parties shall remain bound by the settlement and the petitions are accordingly disposed of as compromised in terms aforesaid.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent is permitted to file on record a letter obtained by him as instructions.

5. Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
