



Thereafter, the petitioner filed a writ petition before the High Court challenging the order of the Appellate Court in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.3749 of 2003 which was dismissed by the learned Single Judge on 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2003. The Division Bench vide the impugned order has dismissed D.B. Special Appeal Writ No.770 of 2003, challenging the said order of the learned Single Judge.

This Court vide order dated 08.05.2017 directed continuation of the petitioner in service until further orders. The order dated 08.05.2017 is as under:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been continuing in the post of Lecturer (Beauty Culture) for the last more than 24 years and that the main matter is still pending before the Civil Court.

In view of the above submission, issue notice.

The petitioner shall be continued in service until further orders.”

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the suit itself has been dismissed by the Trial Court and an appeal against the said judgment is pending before the Additional District Court No.1, Rajasthan. Therefore, she seeks permission of this court to withdraw the special leave petition with liberty to pursue the Appeal before the Additional District Court, Rajasthan and also seek interim order in the said Appeal. In view of the above, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the Special leave petition. The Special leave petition is accordingly disposed of. However, the petitioner is permitted to seek interim order in her pending

appeal. The interim order granted by this Court on 08.05.2017 is continued for a further period of three weeks from today.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
