O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and perusing the material available on record, we see no reason to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, taking into consideration the age of the petitioner, who is reported to be 72 years old, we grant eight weeks' time from today to him to surrender before the concerned Trial Court. Upon

surrender, if the petitioner files an application for regular bail, the said Court is directed to dispose of the said application expeditiously on its own merits and in accordance with law.

We make it clear that no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner for a period of eight weeks from today.

Pending applications filed in the matter also stand disposed of.
