We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

This Court by order dated 06.05.2019 referred the matter to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre and the parties were directed to appear before the Supreme Court Mediation Centre on 09.05.2019. The Supreme Court Mediation Centre had submitted the report along with Deed of Settlement dated 21.06.2019 that the parties have settled all their disputes.

Learned counsel for the parties pray that this appeal be disposed of in terms of the Deed of Settlement dated 21.06.2019. Learned counsel for the parties also agree that in line 5 of para E of the Deed of Settlement the words "shall not claim" have been incorrectly written and may therefore be read as "shall claim". We order accordingly.

Learned counsel for the appellants has handed over two bank drafts of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lacs only) each as per the terms and conditions laid down in the Deed

of Settlement. Learned counsel for the parties have further prayed that the cases filed by them, the details of which are mentioned at Annexure A, be quashed and the request for the same has also been made in the Deed of Settlement. We accept the prayer and direct that the cases filed by the parties, as mentioned in Annexure A, shall stand quashed.

The criminal appeal is disposed of with the above observation.
