O R D E R

Having heard Mr Gautam Narayan, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr Siddhartha Dave, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents, we see no reason to entertain the Special Leave Petition under Article 136 of the Constitution. The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, since the decree for eviction has been passed on the ground of change of user and having regard

to all the facts and circumstances of the case, we grant time to the petitioners to vacate the premises until the end of January 2021 subject to the petitioners' filing usual undertaking in the Registry of this Court within four weeks from today. In the event the petitioners fail to file the undertaking, the decree shall become executable forthwith.
