O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the mother of the minor victim under Section 406 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking transfer of the JJB 167 of 2018 titled as *State vs. Pixx* pending at the Juvenile Justice Board, Gurugram, Haryana to an appropriate court in Delhi.

Heard Mr. Nikhil Borwankar, the learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. Rakesh Dahiya, the learned counsel appearing for respondent No.1 and Mr. Ajay Bansal, the learned counsel for the State of Haryana.

Considering the nature of the allegations as also the grounds pleaded by the petitioner on the background of the first respondent and his family, I deem it fit and proper to allow the transfer petition. Accordingly, the JJB 167 of 2018 titled as *State vs. Pixx* pending at the Juvenile Justice Board, Gurugram, Haryana is transferred to the competent court at the District Court Complex, Saket, Delhi.

Let the records of the case be transferred to the concerned court without delay.

The Transfer Petition is, accordingly, allowed.
