

The petitioner was, at pains, to point out from the memo of writ petition that such fact can be culled out upon reading the petition as a whole.

In our opinion, this Court need not dilate on this matter.

We grant liberty to the petitioner to file review petition before the High Court, including to pray for liberty to amend the memo of writ petition so as to furnish necessary material facts and ask for further relief(s), as may be advised. That request be considered by the High Court on its own merits and in accordance with law.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of accordingly.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
