O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

This special leave petition has been filed against the order dated 30.06.2020 passed by the High Court rejecting the application for interim bail.

The petitioner is accused in a case filed under Sections 420/406/506/34/120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The chargesheet has already been filed. The petitioner has made an application for grant of interim bail for 45 days.

The petitioner submitted that the recommendation has been made by the Committee for release on interim bail on the ground of decongestion in jails. He further submits that he is entitled for interim bail as per the criteria laid down by the High Powered Committee on 24th March, 2020.

We are of the view that the petitioner is entitled for grant of interim bail for 45 days, subject to condition that the petitioner shall mark his presence before the Police Station concerned, on every Sunday.

The special leave petition stands disposed of.
