1. The contempt petitioner-Mahendra Singh Dahiya has also filed writ petition being Writ Petition No.3179 of 2022 before the Delhi High Court.
2. The grievance that is raised in the said writ petition is that though he was allotted plot No.350 Pocket 3A, Sector 28, Rohini, New Delhi one Shri Bhupender Singh is in possession.
3. We find that it will be appropriate that the present contempt petitions are kept pending and the High Court is requested to decide Writ Petition (C) Nos.3179/22 and 3198/2022 expeditiously.
4. List the contempt petitions after six months.
5. In the meantime, the High Court is requested to decide the Writ Petition (C) Nos.3179/22 and 3198/2022 pending before it.
