SLP (C) NO.14087/2019

1. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the first respondent, on instructions, agree that the total amount of compensation payable to the petitioner shall be Rs.19,00,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakh) with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of

filing of the claim petition till the date of actual payment. Ordered accordingly. The impugned Award stands modified accordingly.

2. We grant time of two months from today to the first respondent to deposit the amount in terms of the settlement as recorded above with the Tribunal. After the amount is deposited, the Tribunal shall pass appropriate orders regarding disbursement/investment. We clarify that while depositing the amount with the Tribunal, the first respondent shall deduct the amount which has already been paid or deposited in terms of the impugned awards.

3. The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of in terms of the aforesaid settlement.

4. Court fee be refunded as per rules.

SLP (C) NO.14088/2019

1. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the first respondent, on instructions, agree that in addition to the compensation already granted to the petitioner, an additional compensation amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh) shall be paid to the petitioner with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of filing of the claim petition till the date of actual payment. Ordered accordingly. The impugned awards stand modified accordingly.

2. We grant time of two months from today to the first respondent to deposit the amount in terms of the settlement as recorded above with the Tribunal. After the amount is deposited, the Tribunal

shall pass appropriate orders regarding disbursement/investment.

3. The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of in terms of the aforesaid settlement.

4. Court fee be refunded as per rules.
