We have heard Shri Amit Anand Tiwari, learned AAG appearing for the petitioner(s) and Shri M. Karpagavinayagam, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent.

It is not in dispute that after the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court, the respondent-original writ petitioner was given the short term training and thereafter his

services have been regularised from 22.11.2019. In that view of the matter, we close the present proceedings. However, with the clarification and observation that the respondent-original writ petitioner shall be granted the benefits of regularisation only w.e.f. 22.11.2019 as the respondent himself approached the High Court after a period of 22 years and sought the relief of the regularization belatedly.

With this observation and clarification, the present special leave petition stands disposed of.

All pending applications stand disposed of.
